**Minutes from the August 1, 2013 Meeting**



**What's a Build Sheet?**

There's a lot of nifty paperwork associated with cars. Most people throw the stuff out shortly after buying their car but in some cases the original paperwork is still available with the car. Some of this paperwork is obvious, and some of it is hidden. Obvious paperwork is dealer invoices, window stickers and other sale information often found in the glove box. Some paperwork is hidden or left in the car in various places - mainly the Build Sheet.

The Build Sheet, often considered "the holy grail" to many folks is a cool item to find. It is often the only means of verifying exactly what options came with your particular car, and helps you determine how many Corvettes were produced exactly like yours. The build sheet is what goes down the line with the car when it is being assembled. It indicates to the line worker exactly what goes on that specific car i.e. all the options, type of wiring harness, shocks, radiator, owner package, mirrors, engine, engine harness, transmission, paint codes, interior codes, order number, etc. and the dealer charge to and the dealer shipped to.


