



Vice President's Report (Dave Hunter):

- Dave welcomed New Members: Howard and Delores Maxwell, Michelle and Scott White, Cynthia Puckett and Norm DeLong, Roger and Danielle Boaz, and Debra Lynn and Bruce Chapman.
- Dave handed out badges for new members.

- The Inaugural for 1 1/2 years from now is right on schedule!

- Al Sauvadon discussed the Pismo run, and has a flyer. Run includes staying overnight in Oceano for both nights, June 3rd and 4th. Book your 2 night room reservation directly with Dee Dee at Pacific Plaza Resort, Oceano, (phone (800-300-0903). Mention Paula Sauvadon when you book your room. Rates are (\$211/night for room, \$352/night 2 room suite (accommodates 4 people). Nearby motel are points of interest that include the beach, available hot tub and Al's Special "BBQ your Own" Elks Club dinner Fri night (Steak \$17, Chicken \$14, Mahi Mahi \$12) then Al's wine party at the beach. On Sat, Jun 4, Al has planned an Elvis breakfast in a railroad car, followed by performance driving of San Luis Obispo County back roads to Solvang, a quaint Danish village. After touring Solvang it's off to more back road Corvette driving to the Fes Parker Winery for wine tasting and return trip to Oceano. Links We Like -


Contains web links to other member clubs, the WSCC, Able Chevrolet, etc.


