# Financial concerns at the National Corvette Museum?

Below are two emails which I received from the NCM. You can read them both, and come to your own conclusions.

June 14, 2018

NCM Ambassadors -

Like many of the NCM Ambassadors, I have been a steadfast supporter of the National Corvette Museum and NCM Motorsports Park for many years. I am a lifetime member and major financial supporter of both organizations. I authored the original MSP Strategic Plan in 2009 and served on the MSP Advisory Committee for six years (2009-2014). I developed almost every sponsorship plan for the MSP, including the "one acre club", corporate, hotel, garage and signage sponsorships. During my six years as a volunteer I made more than one hundred presentations and proposals in support of the NCM MSP. Several years ago I made a presentation before the NCM Ambassadors in support of the MSP and the Tire Rack Street Survival teen driver safety program.

In the fall of 2017, I learned of the possibility of very serious financial issues at the NCM. I have come to the opinion that the NCM has failed to report and pay taxes on a very substantial amount of Unrelated Business Income (UBI), and that this problem has been going on for many years.

In April of 2018 I wrote a letter to the NCM board of directors expressing my concerns, and they replied by banning me for life from both the NCM and MSP. I was informed that I would be arrested if I set foot on either property. This action has been devastating to me, as the NCM and MSP have been a very large part of my life for the past twenty years.

The NCM has many stakeholders, including employees, members, clubs, donors, sponsors and the community at large. It is clear that, in addition to the major financial obligations for income tax, penalties and interest, there could be very serious repercussions among NCM supporters.

I am sorry to be the bearer of bad news, but I am hoping the NCM board will resolve this problem promptly.

We apologize if you have already received our message below. We are trying to make sure all Ambassadors receive our information and it appears multiple lists were used for Mr. Blair's mailing.

We first apologize that you have received this email from Mr. Tom Blair and have been brought into this matter. This communication from Mr. Blair is just the most recent of many which the Board has dealt with over the past several months. NCM's Legal Counsel has previously advised Mr. Blair to refrain from communicating with any NCM/MSP Staff and/or Board Members. When he continued to do so, then Mr. Blair was advised that he is not allowed to come onto NCM/MSP property and that if he does the BG City Police will be called. If you have any questions about why these decisions were made, feel free to reach out to me or members of the Board.

Some of you attended the meeting on April 26, 2018 where NCM Members met with the NCM/MSP Boards, Management and Staff. At that meeting Finance Director Christy Thomas presented highlights of the 2017 Audited Financial Report. She also commented that our audit firm, BKD, had expressed a "clean opinion" on the results of their audit. The NCM has received a clean opinion on its audit every year.

NCM/MSP Board, Management and Staff (plus the audit firm) have complete confidence in all the accounting procedures, entries and results that have been reported. The outside and independent audit firm, BKD, completes the tax return and IRS 990 report for the NCM each year. NCM has been, and will continue to be, completely open and transparent regarding financial matters.

From past interactions with Mr. Blair, it has become apparent that he is determined, for some unknown reason, to create discord and disrupt the many good things which are happening with NCM/MSP. My personal advice would be to not respond to and not engage with Mr. Blair. However, if you do so and have any questions as a result, we will certainly be glad to discuss further with you.

Mr. Blair has verbally attacked the NCM and MSP from numerous angles for many months. It is absolutely clear that his intentions are to harm the organizations and targeted staff members. The NCM Management Team and Board are exploring options with our legal counsel to address Mr. Blair's ongoing harassment and untrue statements about the NCM.

We have always encouraged (and still do) that if any member and especially any Ambassador has any questions concerning your Museum regarding any aspect of operations to contact our management team, our staff or our board.






