Call to Order – Call to Order – 7:35pm by President Tim Denham at the Discovery Bay Yacht Club, Bilge Room. Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Attending: 27 members and 1 guest

President Report – Tim Denham

Guest speaker - John Fleming service representative from Abel Chevrolet talked about their services, the current Corvette inventory, and answered questions.

Abel Chevrolet has been owned by the same family for 95 years. They work on Chevrolets and also work on other brand cars. There is a current sales promotion for the next 2 months. Buy 3 tires and the 4th is free. John noted the importance of extended warranties which they offer.

Craig mentioned that for next year they may do something a little different and include Monterey.

Vice President Report for April 2026 Newsletter

Hi, well the car show season has kicked off, and our first Discovery Bay Cars and Coffee of the year occurred this past Saturday (April 18th) and we had a great turnout of Corvettes. I counted about 28 Corvettes in all, with about 10 being from outside our Club. This gave me an opportunity to hand out "We like your Corvette" cards and see if we can drum up membership. The event was held at a new location in Discovery Bay. It was in Mountain Mike's Pizza parking lot on Discovery Bay Blvd., just outside the front of Vin Alegro restaurant. This parking area will replace the Marina parking lot for the foreseeable future. Of course, there were a number of other cars as well, and the usual door prizes. Next month's gathering will be an actual Car Show, with participation costing \$40 to enter. I'm thinking of entering my 1941 Plymouth Pickup since the door prize I won was free participation in the Car Show on May 16th. There are a number of other Car Shows coming up, including the East Contra Costa Historical Society show on June 28th which only takes cars that are 1975 and older.

The big news from GM this month was the release of the new Grand Sport and its' new pricing. The Grand Sport will come in 4 versions: the GS, the GS Convertible, the GSX and the GSX Convertible. The Grand Sport has always been a great package of performance and styling for a Corvette, placed right in the middle of the Corvette lineup. It has a wide body like a Z06, but has the base engine of the Stingray, and in this case the new base engine is the 409ci LS6 V8 (535hp) (which will be the standard engine for all Stingrays soon). And of course, the "X" models have the front wheel electric motor and therefore will eliminate the need for the E-Ray package going forward. Starting prices for a GS are \$88,495. Along these same lines, there was recently a new video from Jay Leno's Garage where he featured the ZR1X that he bought and recently took delivery, and includes a visit from the GM President, Mark Reuss. Finally, I have presented below the latest photo of the NCM Expansion Museum progress in Bowling Green. Completion is scheduled for November of this year, with the public opening being in the first half of 2027. We, as a Club, are considering a \$1,000 donation for our Club name to be on the Honor wall. We are waiting on the design of the Honor wall before we make a final decision on the donation.

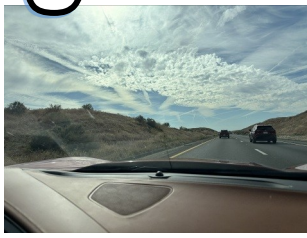
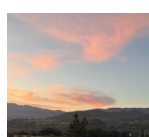

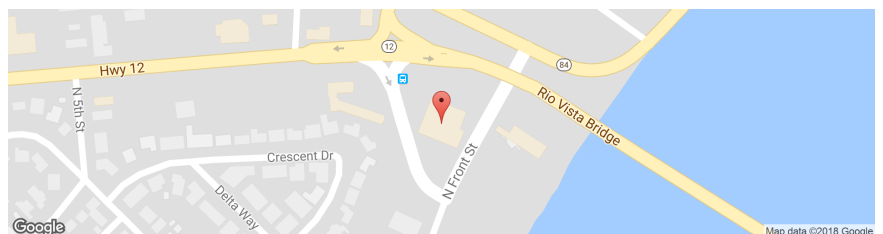
