Ralph noted that Calvin Jones (who had passed) had many tools and there is a list of items with pictures for those interested.

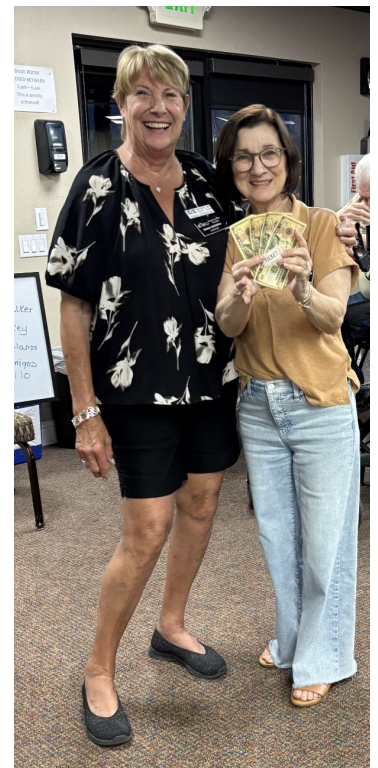

Hi, with the weather getting better, it allows more time to get the Corvette out and drive it. Since my last article, we had the Hiller Aviation Museum run. We had 13 cars (24 members) make the run to San Carlos. Traffic that morning was a bit heavy, but we all managed to stay reasonably close together. That was my first time at this museum, and they sure do pack in a lot of planes, helicopters and drones into a rather small place. We had a docent tour as well. We then headed to Harry's Hof Brau in Redwood City for lunch. They are a busy place on the weekends, but thanks to the staff, they were able to 'cone off' 13 parking spots in advance so that we didn't have to park on the street. I had requested to eat in their patio, but as the weather started to get colder leading up to the run (and mist starting to make an appearance that morning), the restaurant was able to pivot and get us good seats inside.

As some of you may know, at the April 'Cars and Coffee', I won a raffle prize which was a free entrance coupon to the 'Kustoms and Klassics Car Show' in Discovery Bay. I attended the event recently and took my old 1941 Plymouth pickup. There was a good turnout of about 100 cars (and of these, there were about 7 Corvettes), and the new location near Mountain Mike's worked out well. I didn't win an award, however. I think the judges are looking for 'customs', and my truck is stock, like the day it came off the assembly line. I'll be entering it again at the East Contra Costa Historical Society show on June 28th which only takes cars that are 1975 and older.

Earlier this month, Jenifer and I traveled with friends to Santa Fe, New Mexico for a vacation. While we were there, we visited the historic downtown area and walked the path that Route 66 (pre-1937) took through the town. We knew that the 100th year of the Route 66 celebration was underway, with lots of Route 66 street markings, and memorabilia. As we walked the exact route, we saw a lot of classic cars and other vehicles making the Route, probably from end to end, including several C8's that appeared to be caravanning. We talked to one couple that was in their RV making the trip over the course of 2 months. What a great year to make this trip. Jenifer and I made the trip 7 years ago coming home from Bowling Green, and followed the path from Springfield, Missouri to Barstow, California. Lots of fun, especially in the Corvette. We didn't pass through Santa Fe back then, because we were following the post-1937 route that is more southern, heading through Albuquerque, and nowadays paralleling I-40.

Finally, like last month, I have presented, below, the latest photo of the NCM Expansion Museum progress in Bowling Green dated May 6th. Completion is still scheduled for November of this year, with the public opening being in the first half of 2027. As you probably all know by now, we, as a Club, are considering a \$1,000 donation for our Club name to be on the Honor wall. We are waiting on the design of the Honor wall before we make a final decision on the donation.

2027 Corvette pricing

Stingray: LS6 409 engine taking it from the LT2's 495 hp /470 foot pounds of torque to 535 hp and 520 foot pounds of torque. The price on the base car went from 72.5 K in 2026 to 73.5 K, only \$1000! Huge win! The LS6 is still a push Rod V8, but it has direct and port injection with active fuel management. That means that you have two different injectors for each cylinder. It has a tunnel ram intake manifold, high velocity ports and a 95 mm throttle body. this is worth every penny of \$1000! Center exit exhaust via Z06 is now available on the Stingray.

Grand Sport: coop starts at 88.5 K and convertible starts at 95.5 K, Putting the grand sport smack in the middle between the Stingray and the ZO6. Giving the grand sport, the aesthetic advantage of a Z06 with a performance upgrade from the Stingray. It's only 15 K above the stingray, but 32K below the Z06. If the grand sport performs anywhere near what we expect. This could become one of the hottest selling Corvette trends GM has ever released!

Grand Sport X: coupe starts at 112.2 K, convertible starts at 119.2 K. The outgoing 2026 E-Ray coop started at 111.1 K, and convertible started at 118.1 K confirming that grand sport X is replacing the E-Ray.

Z06: price went from 120.2 K in 2026 to 121.4K in 2027, which is \$1200 more. Essentially flat, another huge win for buyers.

ZR1: This is where GM dropped the hammer! Pricing went from 184.5 K in 2026 to 197.2 K in 2027. This is a \$13,000 increase.

And if that shocked you wait till you hear about the ZR1X!

ZR1X: pricing went from 209.6 K in 2026 to 227.4K in 2027, which is a staggering \$17,800 increase! Once optioned ZR1X pricing is pushing deep into exotic car territory! We are talking \$300,000 plus MSRP builds depending on the spec! This is massive! Clearly, GM knows the demand for these halo cars is sky high, and they are not about to miss out on monetizing on that demand aggressively! I understand why they did it, but there's no question this pricing will price many enthusiasts out of ZR1 and ZR1X market entirely!

2027 pre-orders opened April 16th and Allocations were started at the end of April. Production starts second and third quarter depending on model.

Honestly, 2027 GM pricing has brought far more good news than bad! The clear winners are Stingray, Grand Sport, Grand Sport X, and Z06 buyers!

The losers are ZR1 and ZR1X buyers!

GM kept the majority of the lineup, surprisingly reasonable, but they absolutely hammered the top end halo cars! Maybe that was the plan all along. Keep the core lineup attractive, and then maximize profit on the cars that everyone's desperate to own.

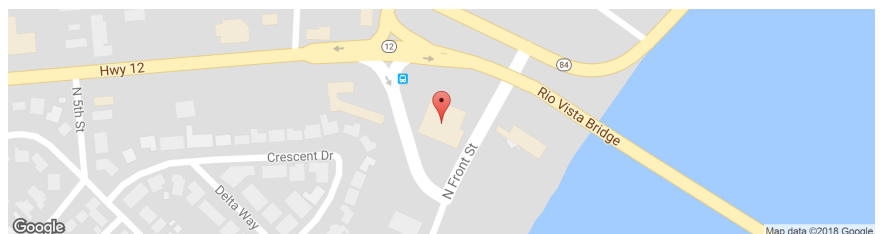

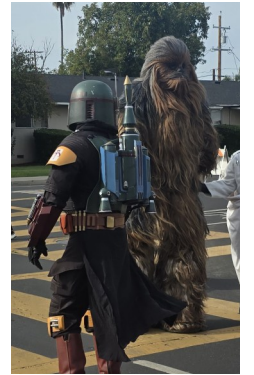
