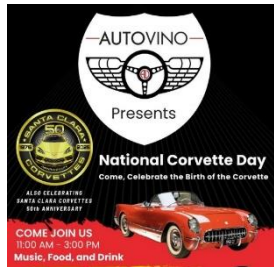




## Run to Auto Vino Corvette Day, June 28, 2026
